Ronald J. Oudiz, MD, FACP, FACC, FCCP is Professor of Medicine, David Geffen School of Medicine at UCLA and is the Director of the Pulmonary Hypertension Center and Faculty Cardiologist at the Los Angeles Biomedical Research Institute at Harbor-UCLA Medical Center in Southern California. Dr. Oudiz received his medical school training at the University of Southern California in Los Angeles, his Internal Medicine training at the University of California, San Diego, and his training in Cardiovascular Diseases at Harbor-UCLA Medical Center in Torrance, CA. He is board-certified in Internal Medicine and Cardiovascular Diseases. Dr. Oudiz is a past holder of scientific research awards from the American Heart Association and the National Institutes of Health.

He has authored several papers in pulmonary hypertension and has presented his research at national and international seminars. Dr. Oudiz is the immediate past Editor-in-Chief of the scientific publication *Advances in Pulmonary Hypertension*. He has participated in several trials of innovative medical treatments for pulmonary hypertension (PH), many of which are still ongoing. Dr. Oudiz's recent focus has been to describe the physiologic abnormalities that are caused by PH using measurements of lung gas exchange during exercise, and to study exercise rehabilitation as a treatment modality for patients with PH.
