Dr. Richard Silver is Professor of Medicine at the Medical University of South Carolina (MUSC), where he served as Director of the Division of Rheumatology & Immunology from 1996-2018, and Interim Chairman of the Department of Medicine from 2011-2012. He is a graduate of the University of Tennessee (B.S.) and Vanderbilt University School of Medicine (M.D.). Dr. Silver completed training in Internal Medicine at the University of North Carolina-Chapel Hill, and in Rheumatology at London's Northwick Park Hospital and at the University of California-San Diego. He joined the MUSC faculty where he has conducted studies of scleroderma for the past four decades. In 1994, Silver was elected to membership in the American Society of Clinical Investigation. MUSC's Board of Trustees named him a "Master Teacher" and bestowed the University's highest academic recognition, Distinguished University Professor. He serves on the Medical and Scientific Advisory Board of the Scleroderma Foundation and was named the Foundation's "Doctor of the Year" in 2007. He was elected to Master in the American College of Rheumatology in 2014. Dr. Silver's major clinical interest is pulmonary complications of Systemic Sclerosis.
